#### Cost:

*Pricing is varied depending on the class. There are several payment plan options. Call for payment plan details.*

As a general guideline, costs average \$38-\$52 monthly for an hour or 45 minute class, depending on the payment plan you choose. Our back-to-back 45-minute classes are designed for cross training and in some instances are economically priced as 1 ½ hour classes.
